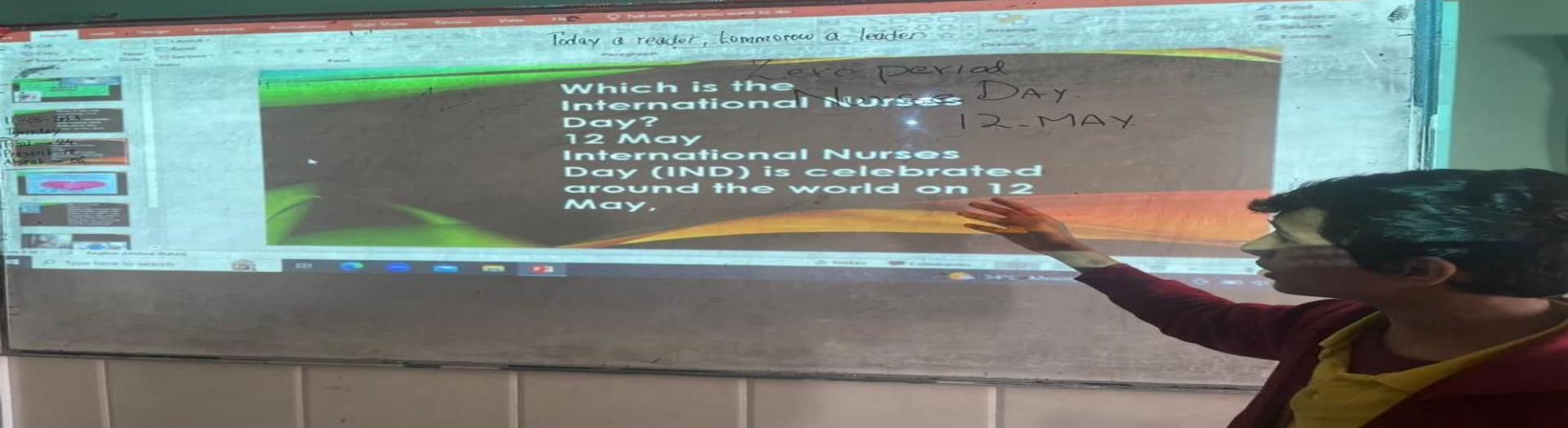
ROBOTICS DAY

collective noun.	Collective nouns refer to groups of people or things.	Team, choir, Army.

Types of Nouns

• Proper Nouns

The words for people, places and things are. ex:
Albert Einstein

Common Nouns

Non-specific people, place, things etc.

ex: Mom, city, religion etc

Abstract Noun

Something that you can not perceive with your five senses

EX: Belief, love, pride

collective Nouns

Refer to a group of things as one whole

ex: Bunch, audience, flock, group, family

Nouns

A Noun is a naming word. It can name anything: a person, animal, place, thing, feeling

Types of nouns:

Common Nouns

Any noun that name anything that is shared by every person or thing of the same class. They do not refer to an particular person or thing.

For example: Teachers, students, boys, cook, door.

Proper Nouns

Any noun that name a particular person or thing. Proper nouns could be names, the name of our friends, Name of, school, the name of our building, the name of our state, the name of our country.

Collective Nouns

Collective nouns are nouns that name a group or a collection of things of the same kind.

For example: Bunch, crowd, bunch, class, shoe collection.

Abstract Nouns

Abstract nouns are nouns that name ideas, thoughts, feelings that a person can feel within himself but cannot experience through his five senses. That is through sight, touch, smell, hearing, taste or taste.

For example: Honesty, happiness, sorrow, excitement, boredom.

Material Noun

Material Nouns: These are nouns that have a material, a substance or an ingredient that other things are made from.

For example: brass, cotton, plastic, rubber, wood, silk.

Countable Nouns

Countable nouns are those that can be counted - nouns like - Fingers, flowers, desks, children can be counted.

Uncountable Nouns

Nouns like water, milk, rice, sugar, cannot be counted as we use quantity for uncountable nouns. For example we say, a little water, a lot of water, a lot of milk, too much sugar, very less rice, we usually use countable nouns with this noun.

For example: we say one glass of water, ten kilograms of sugar.
