




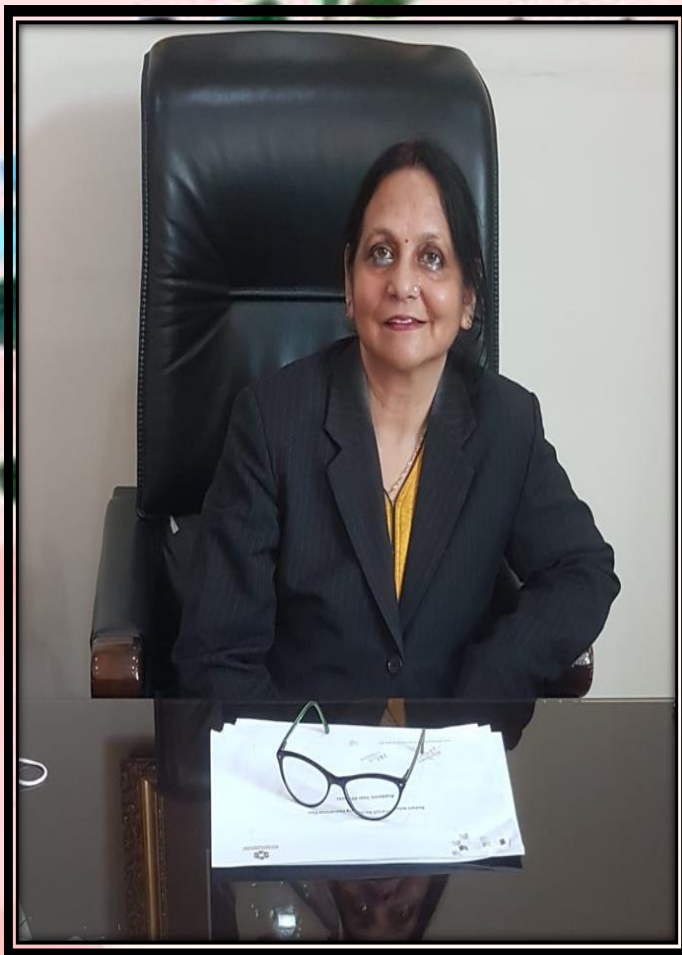

Dear Parent,

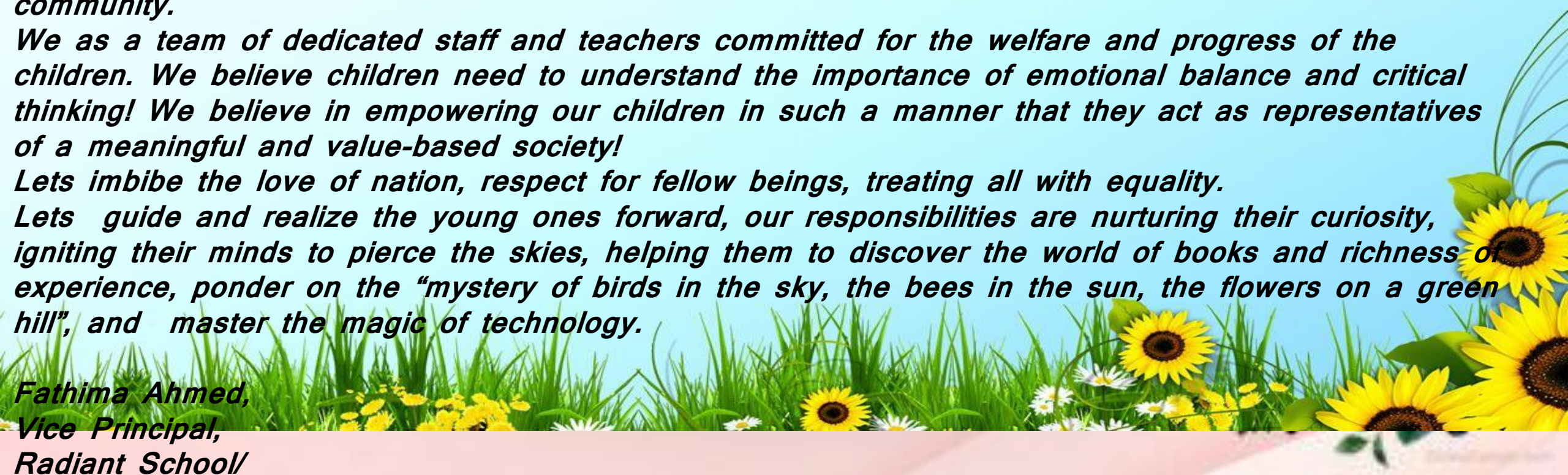

MATHEMATICS WEEK

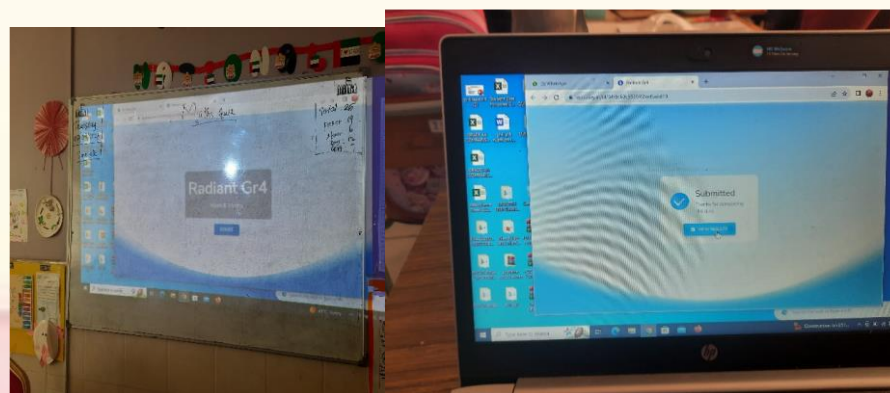
OBJECTIVE – To enable each child to learn about the different math arts.
