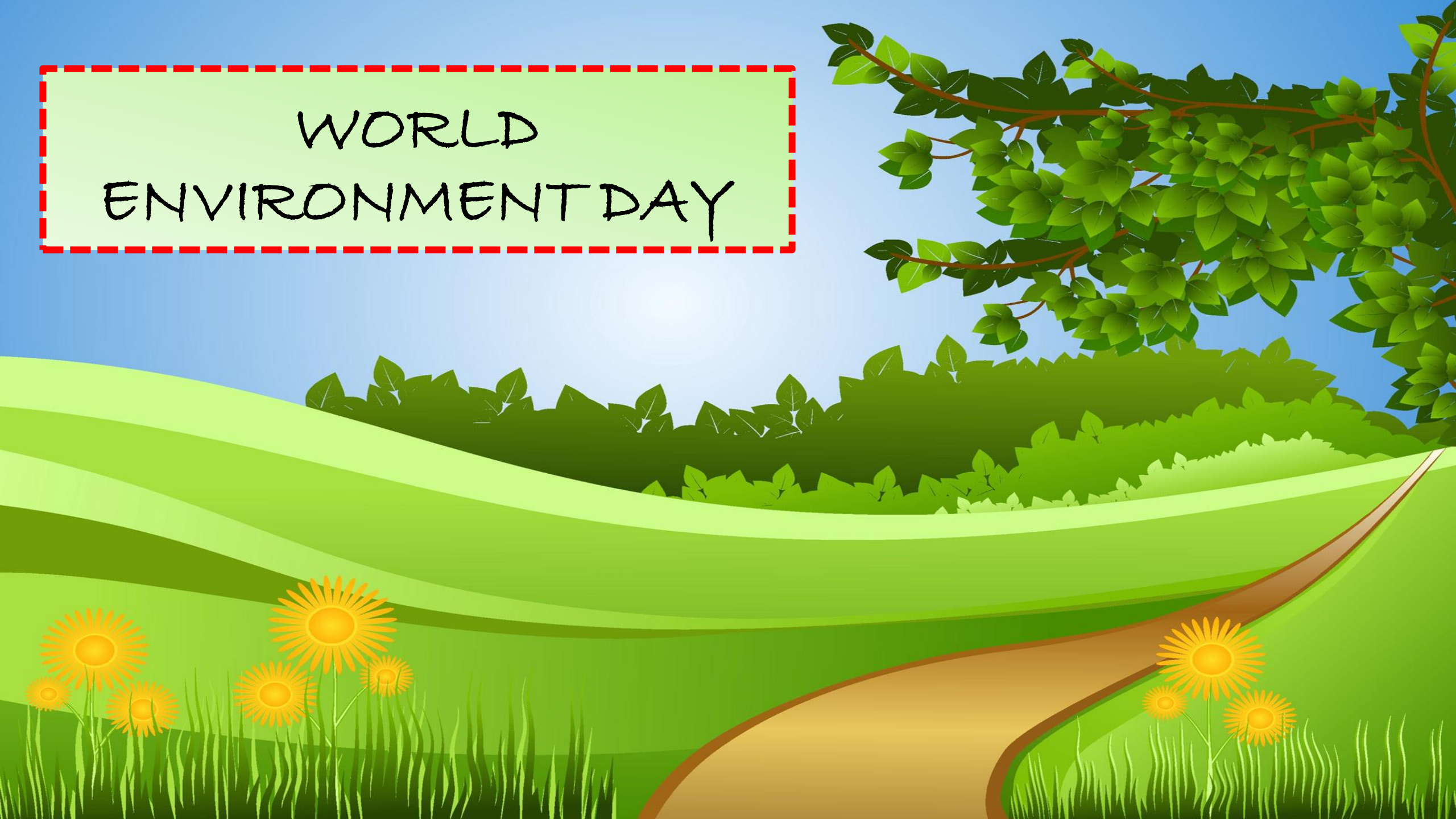
Lets imbibe the love of nation, respect for fellow beings, treating all with equality.

WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY

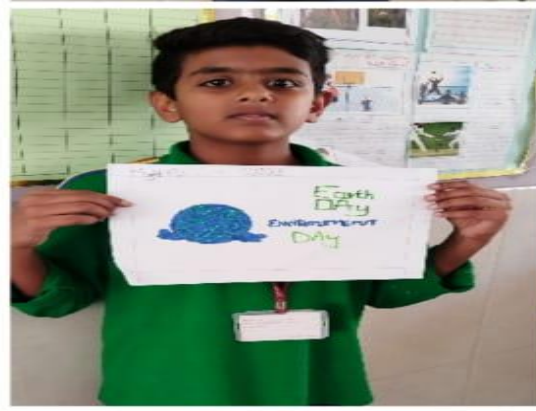

- **Students did this activity with great pleasure. They made attractive posters about world environment day. They have understood the steps to be taken to make our environment healthy.**

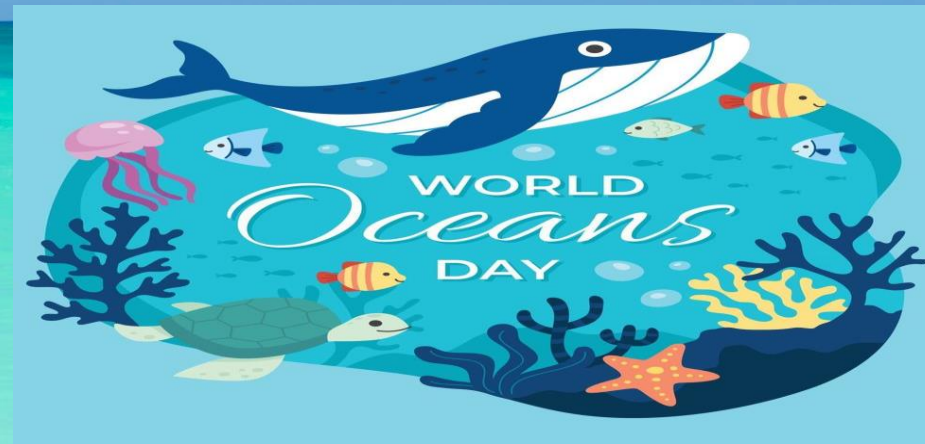




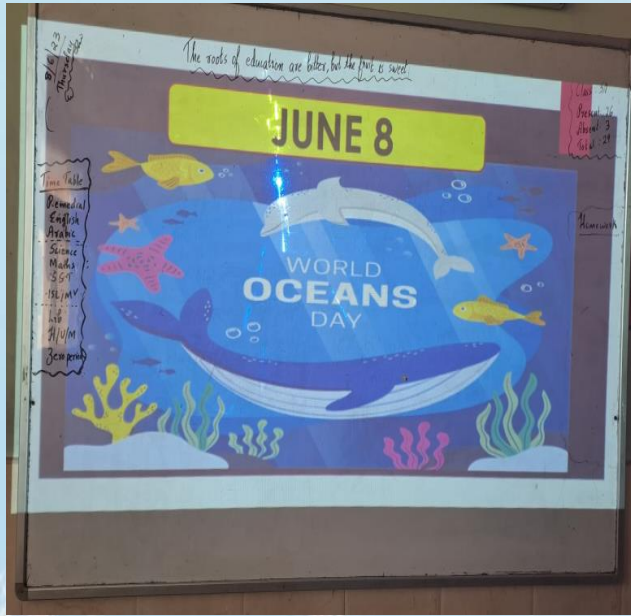
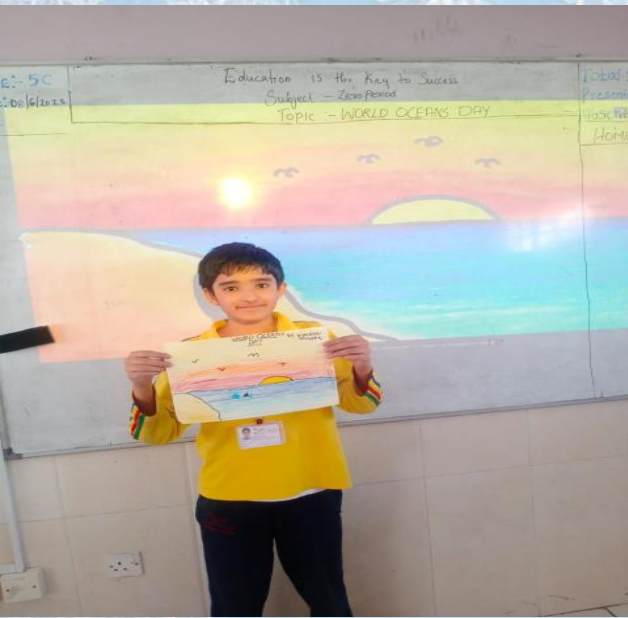


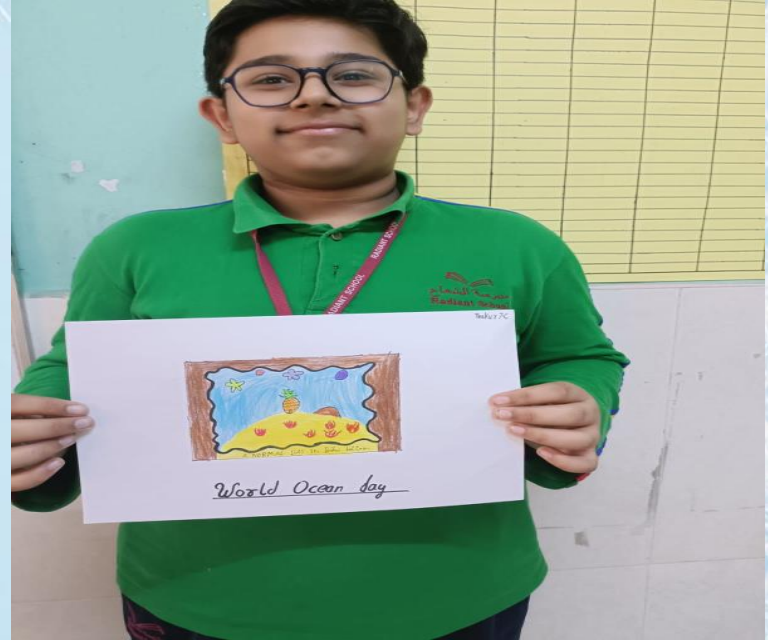
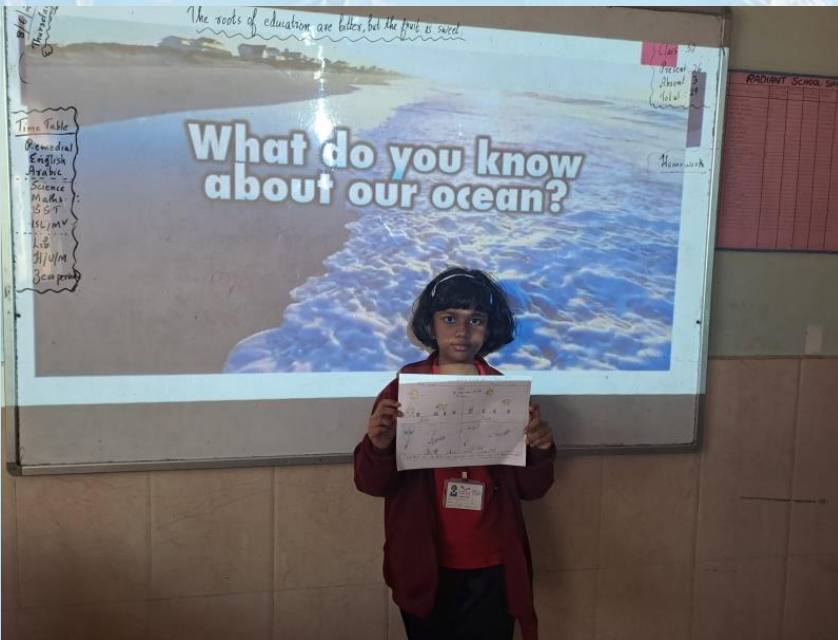


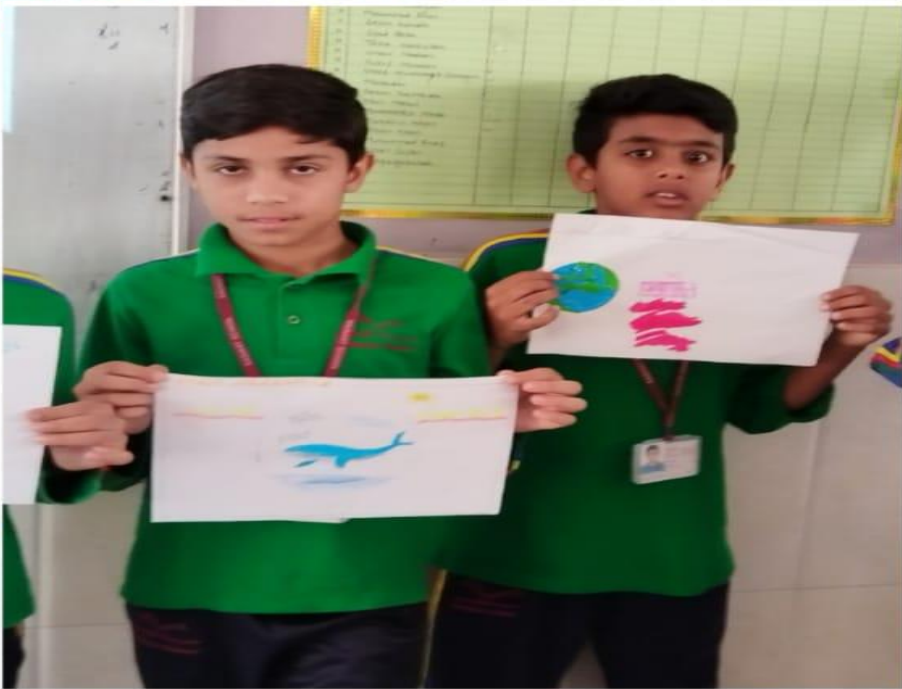
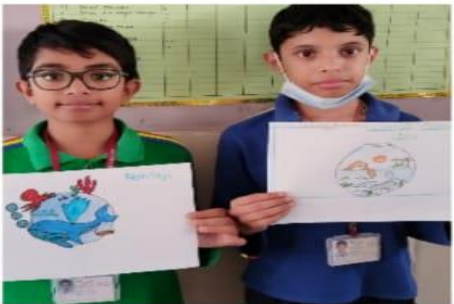
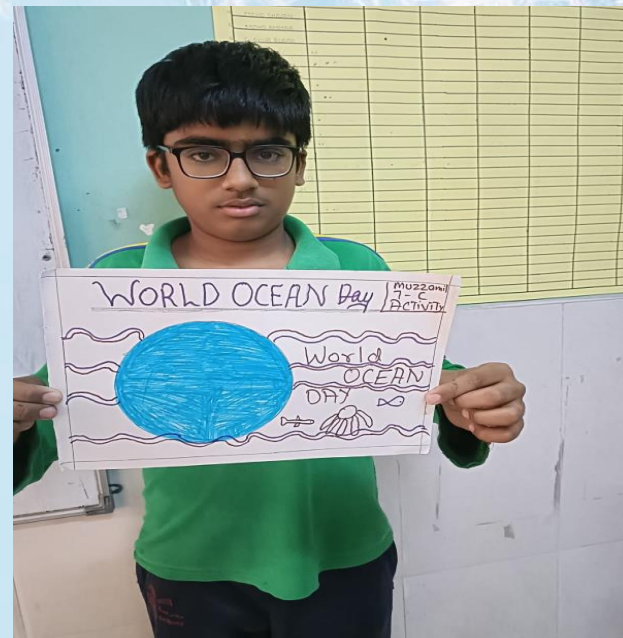
WORLD OCEAN DAY

 - **Students were made into different groups and were made to prepare posters regarding World Oceans Day. Students were also encouraged to deliver a speech about The World Oceans Day.**

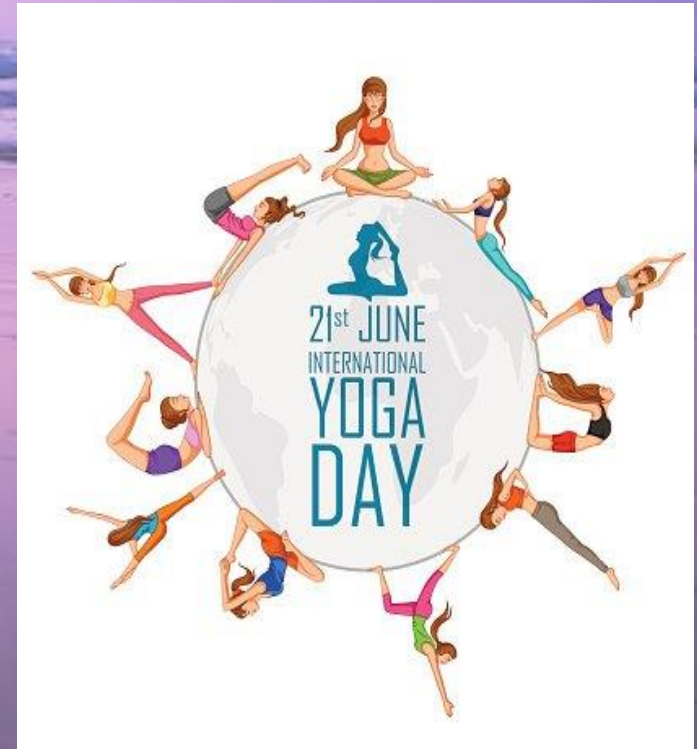
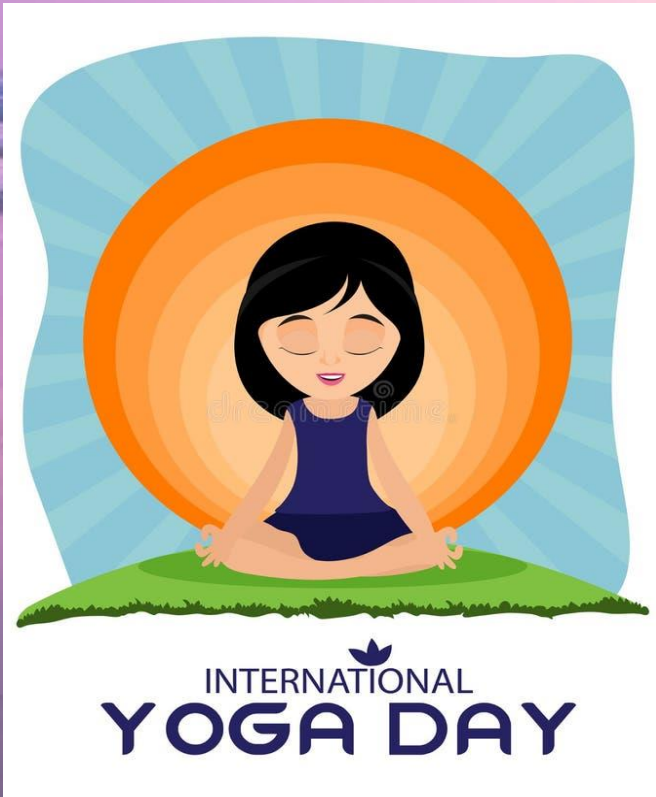









INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY

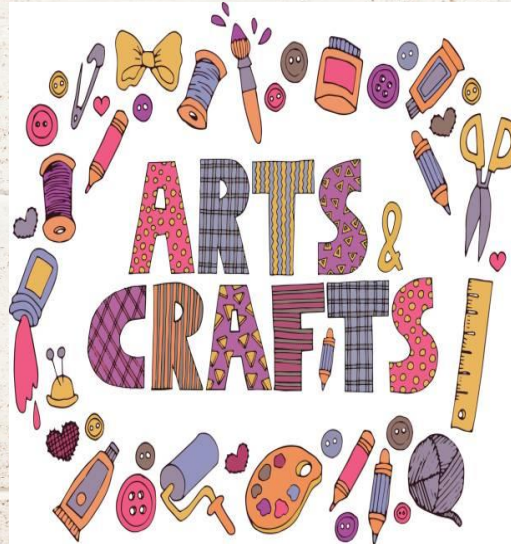

 - **The students of Radiant School participated actively in the yoga session and made it a success.**



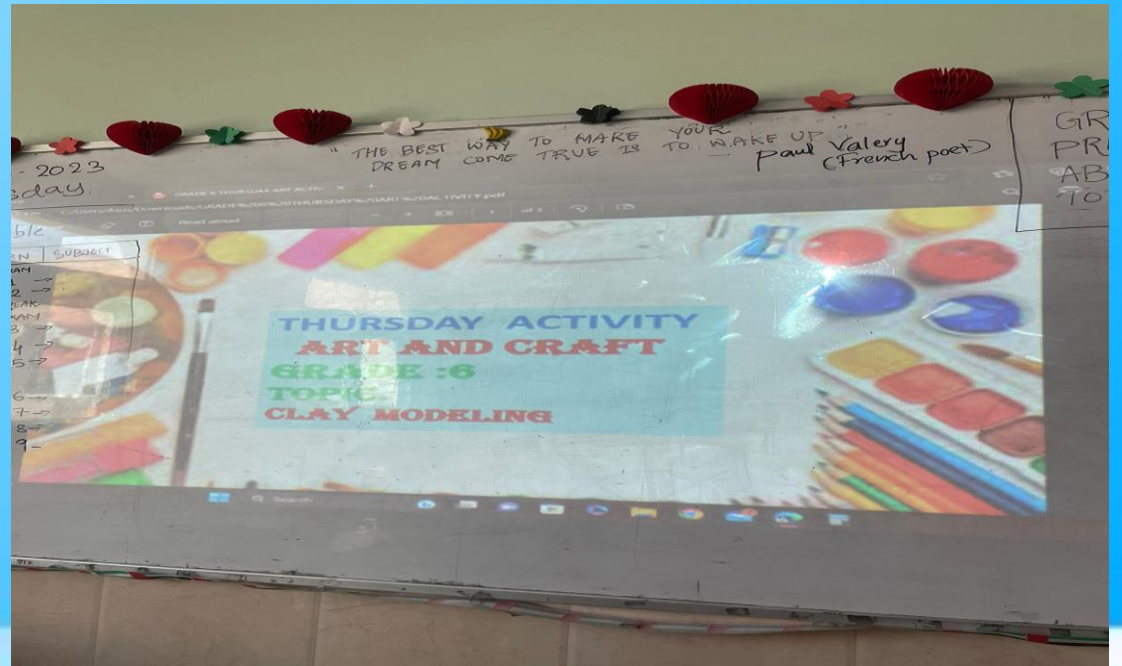
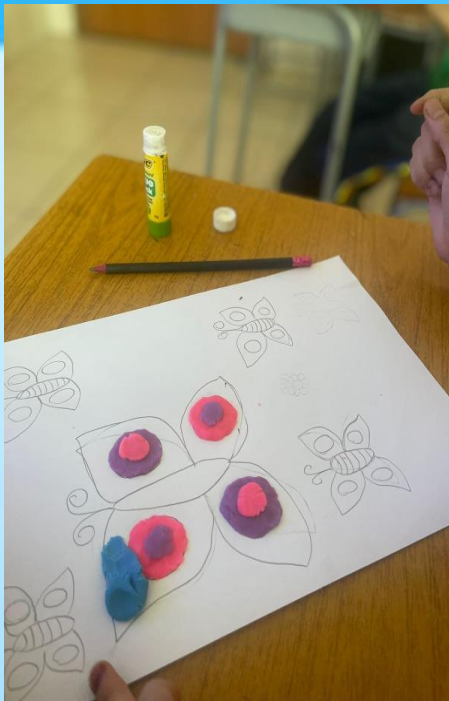


ART GALLERY

INTER SCHOOL ART COMPETITION

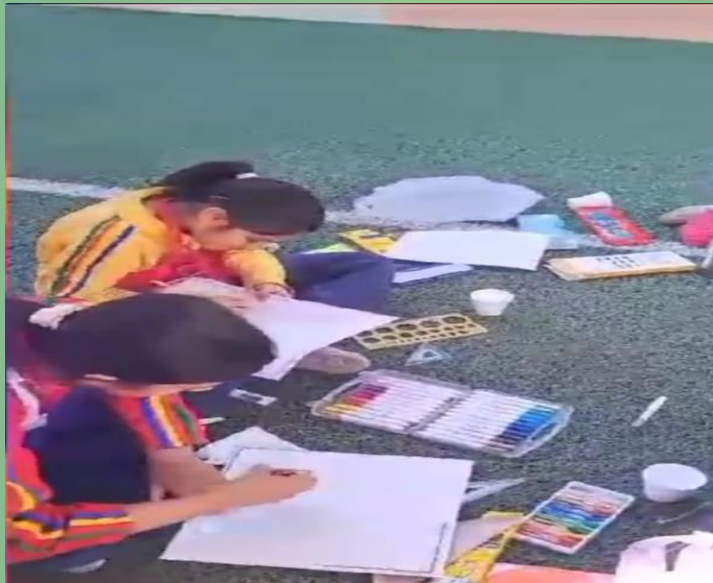




- ❖ **Radiant School had conducted and Interschool Art Competition.**
