# INVESTITURE CEREMONY

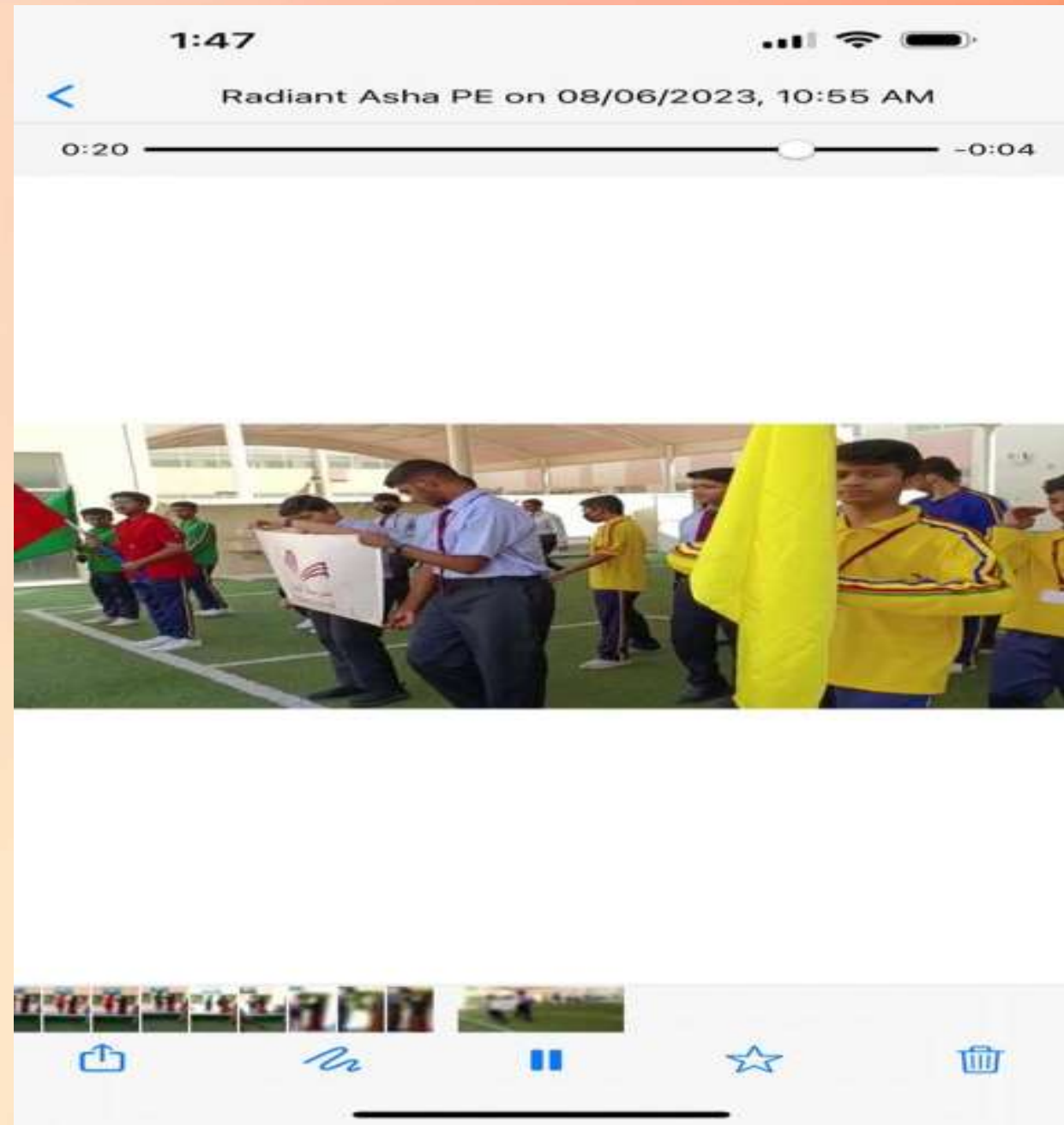
Radiant School witnessed Investiture Ceremony for academic session 2023-24.

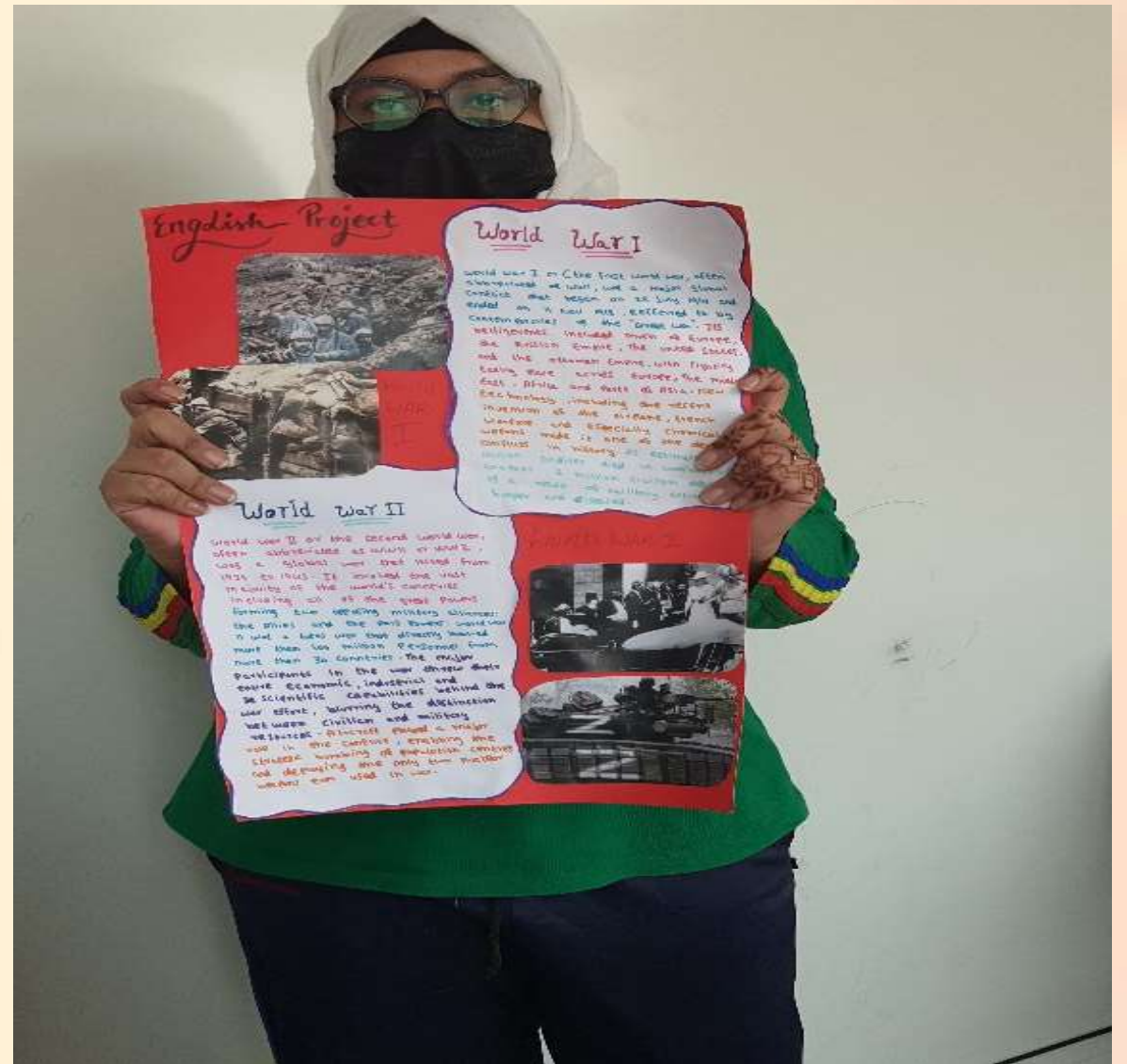
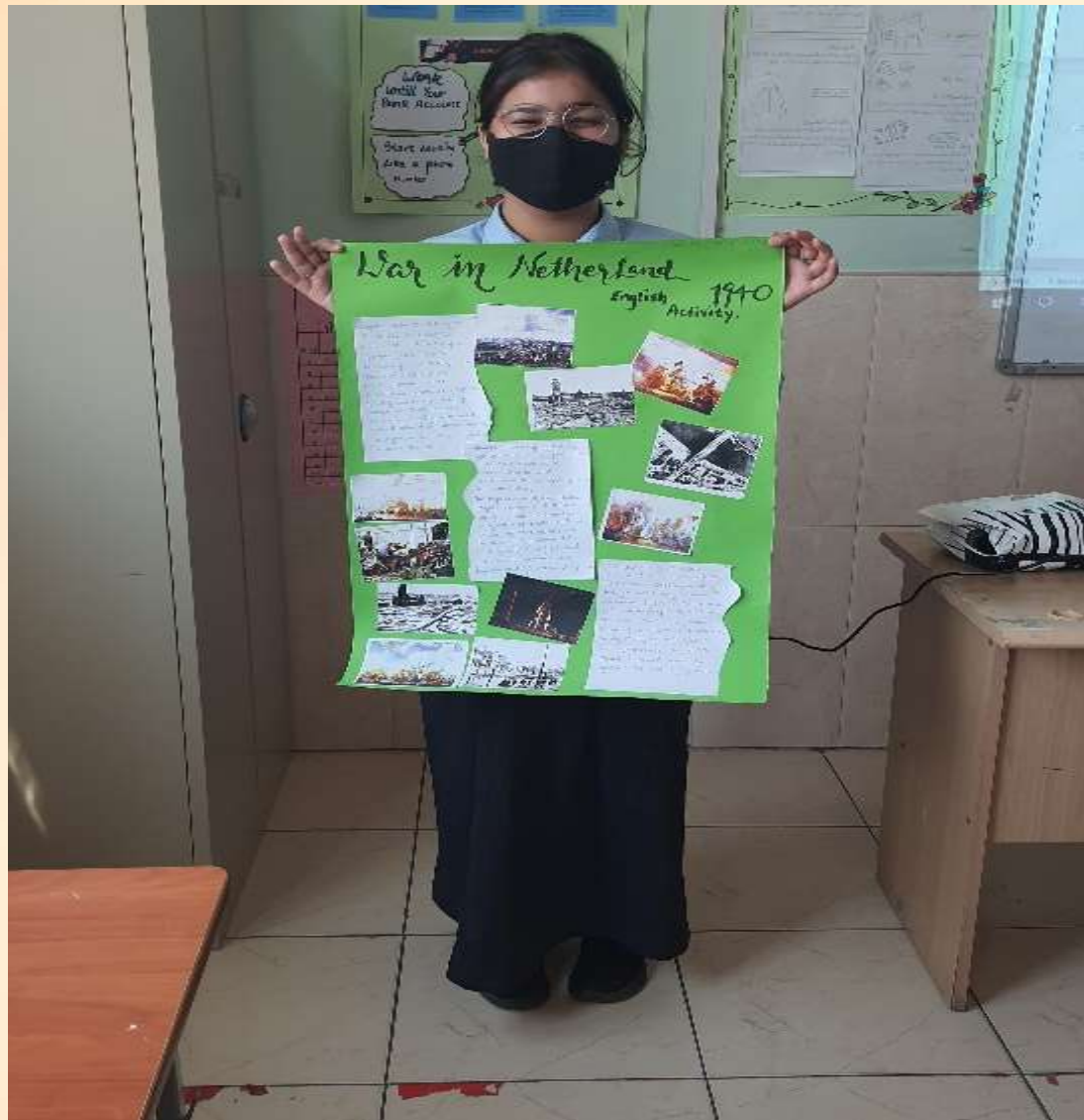
