# ELAG DAY


Raise it high and raise it proud!

The national campaign was launched in 2013 by HH Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Vice President of the UAE and Ruler of Dubai, to honor the country's past, present and future.














National Cancer Awareness Day is observed on 7th November in India every year since 2014 to create public awareness about early detection, prevention, and treatment of cancer.

The scientific exhibition facilitates and supports students' exploration of innovative approaches. Students participate in group activities and social interactions to learn new ideas.



















