PROCEDRUEFORREPORTINGCOMPLAINTS:

- 1. If apparent or teach wishest or egister a complaint related to a buse or neglect, they have various options including.

 - Theycanofficiallyreportinthecybercrimereportingforminourschoo 1 portal if they want to remain anonymous providing substantialevidence.
 - ❖ The school head/ E safety member / counsellor whomever received the complaint should immediately inform the counselling department of school or E safety group. The E safety committee members will determine the next steps to be taken. The committee needs to verify the dates / evidence / apparent / places / personnel involved. This preliminary information gathering.
