



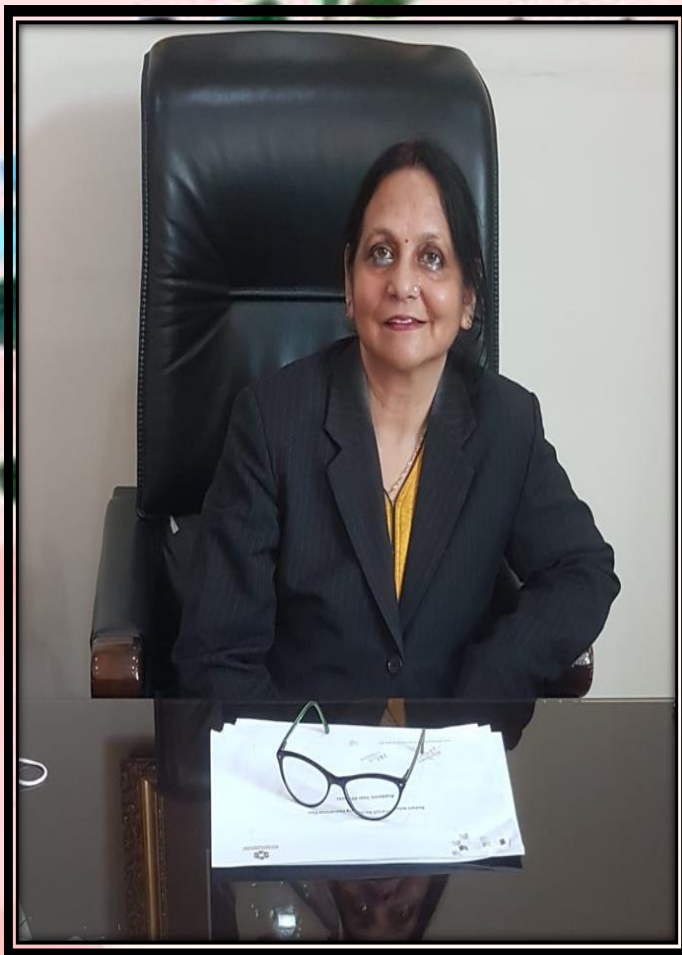

*Dear Parent,*

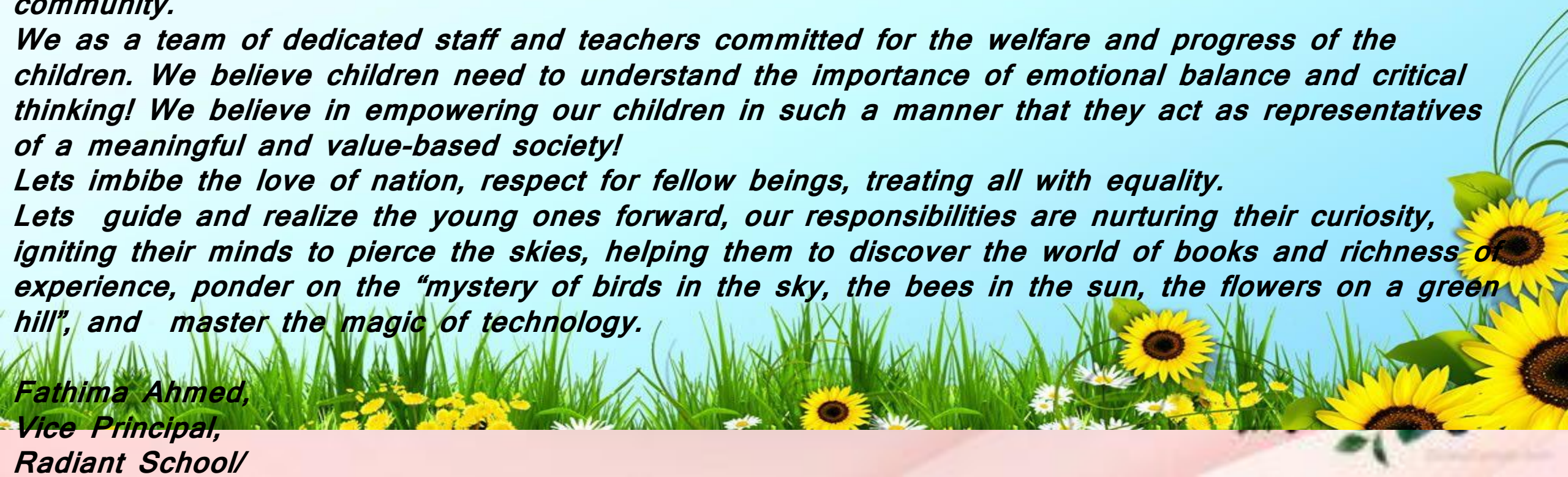

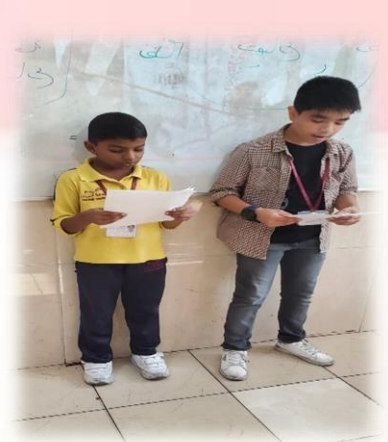
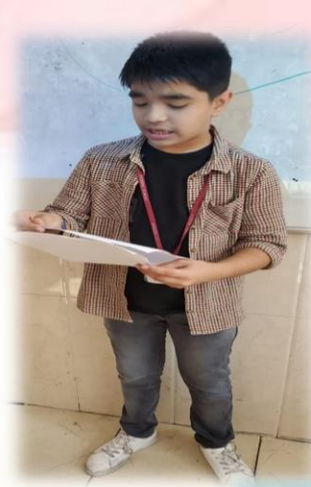
## SST ART INTEGRATED ACTIVITY

## **OUTCOME:**

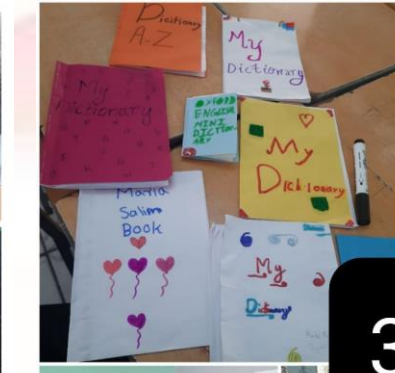

## **OUTCOMES:**

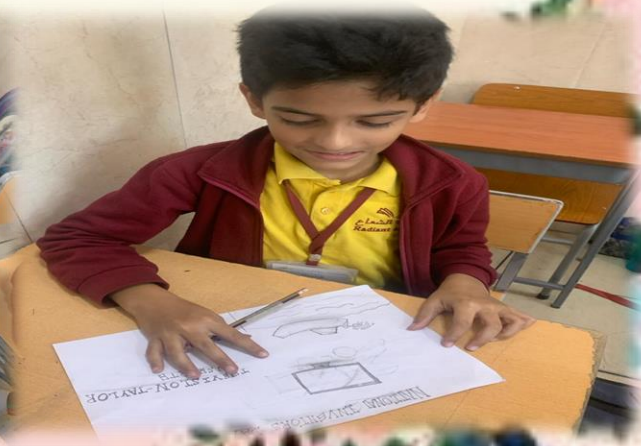
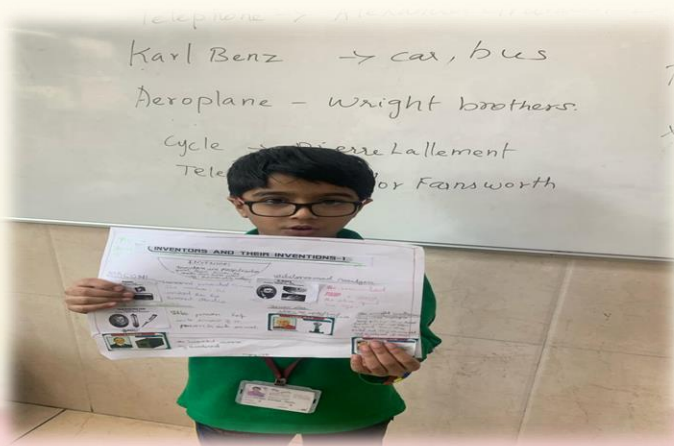
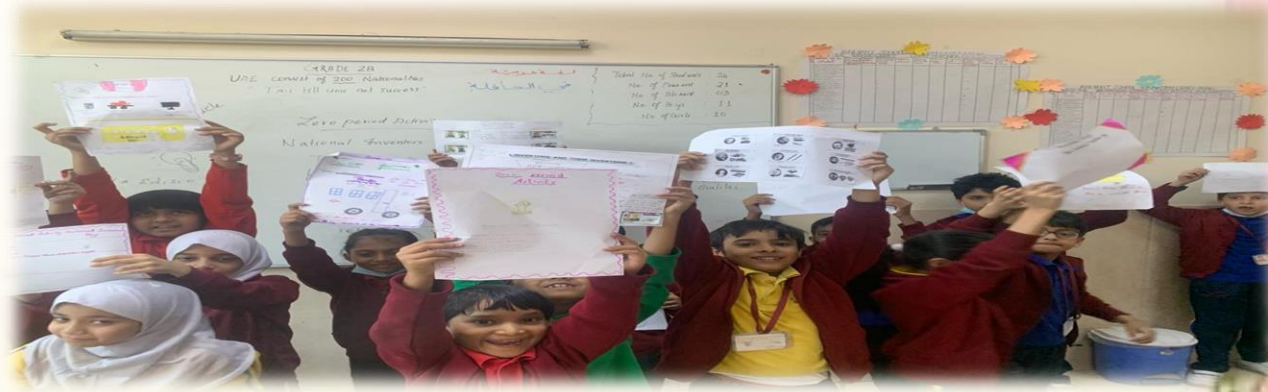
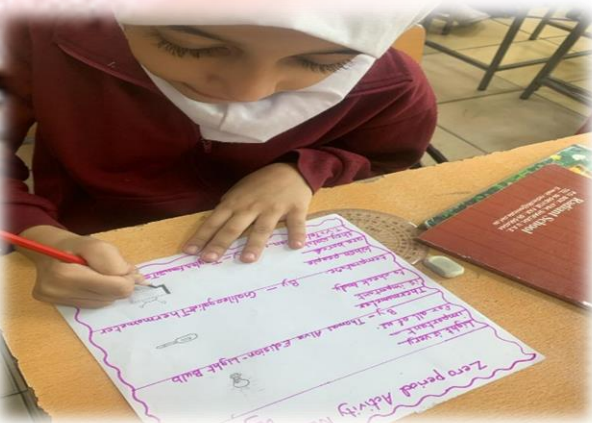

Time management, observation skill, empathy, thinking skill and research skill.

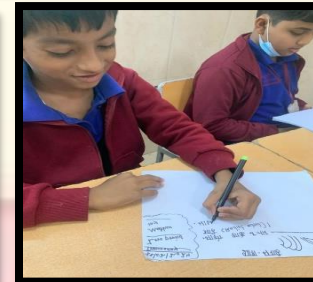
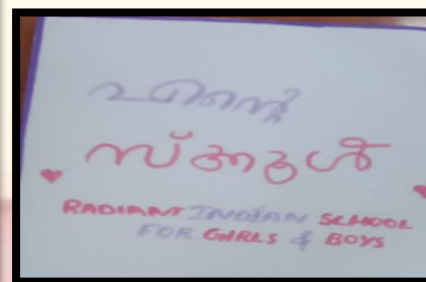
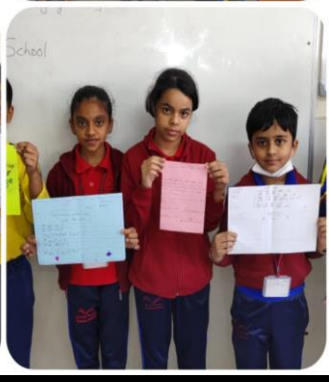
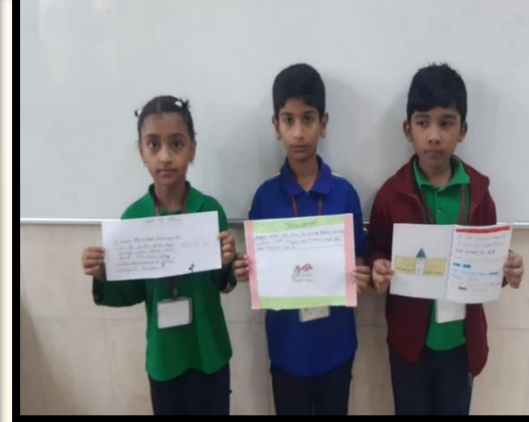
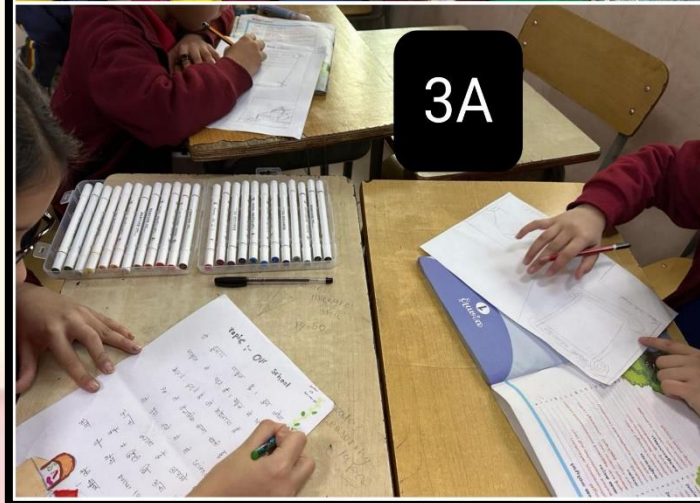
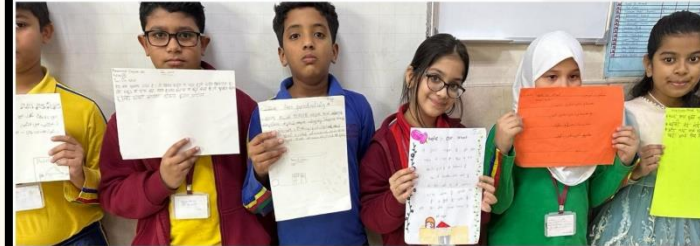
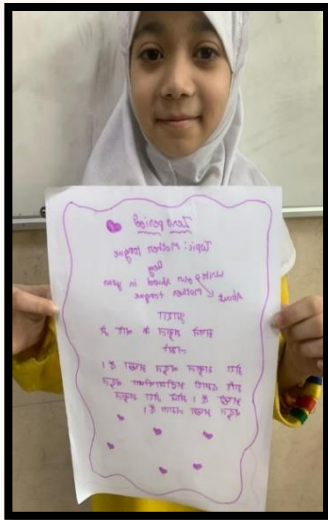
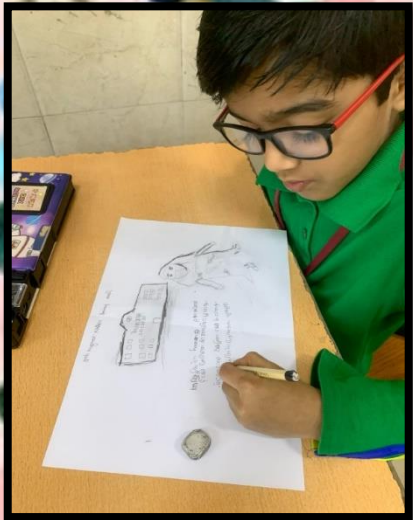
