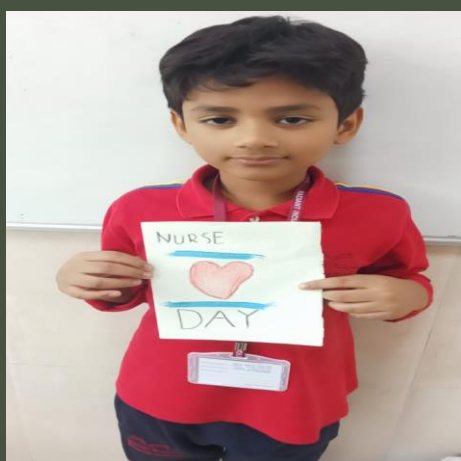
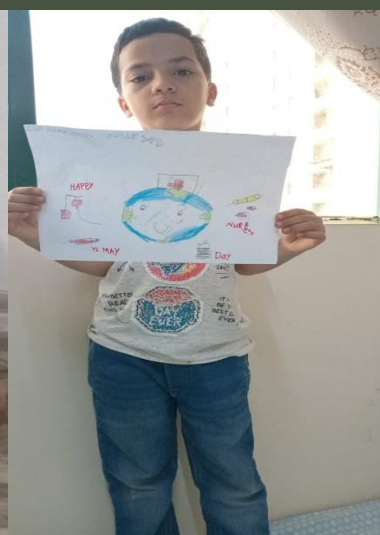
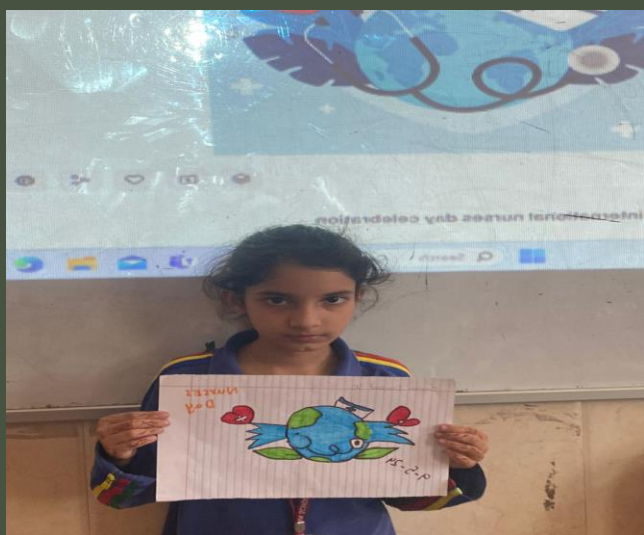
International Nurse Day: Honoring Healthcare Heroes

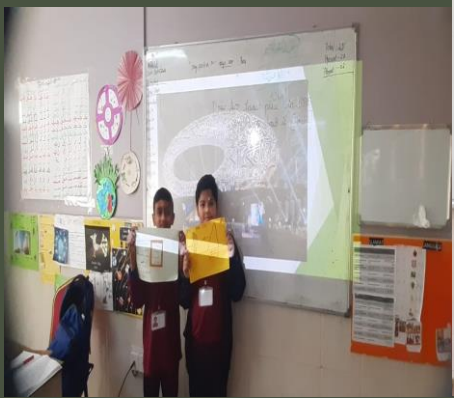
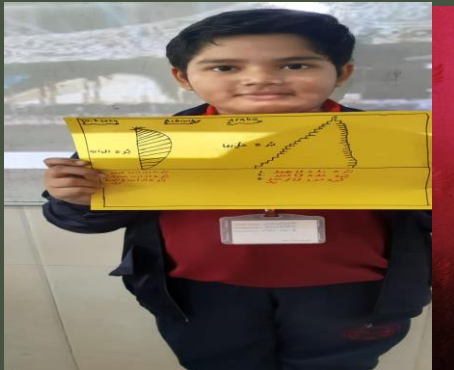
Arabic Day
