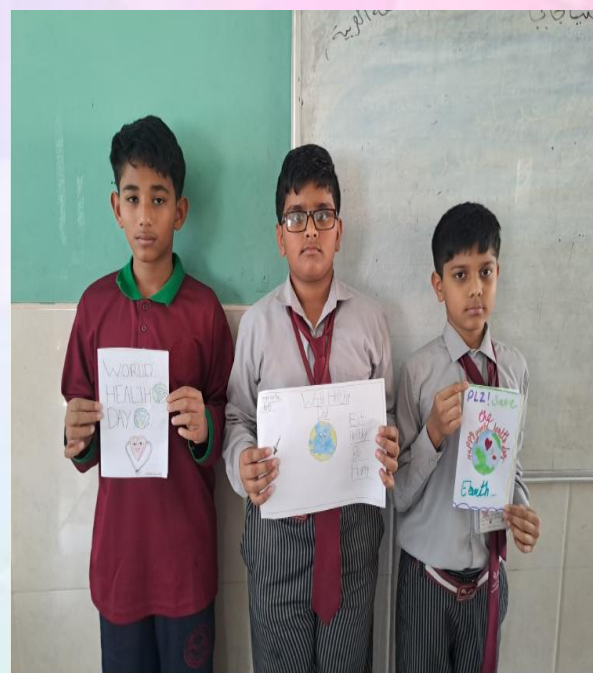
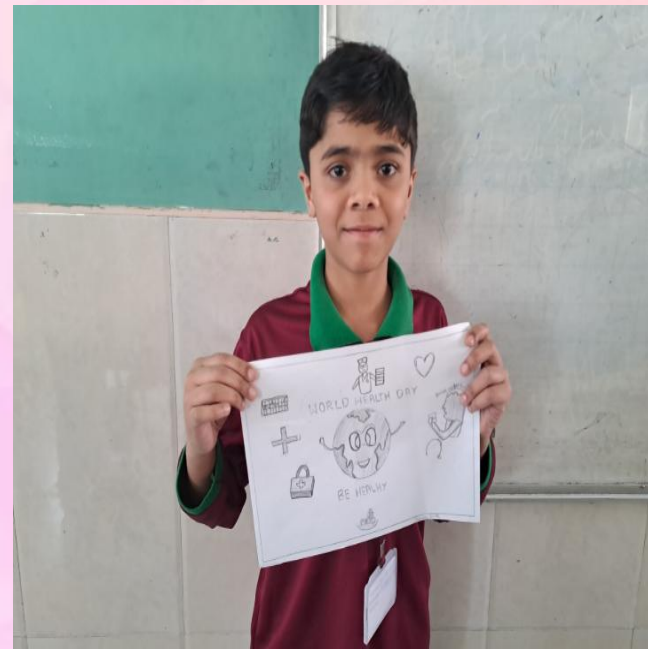
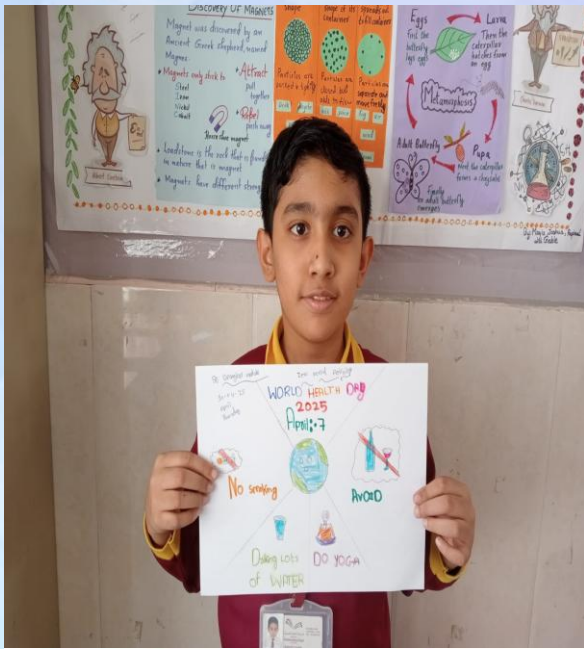


World Health Day 2025

World Heritage Day

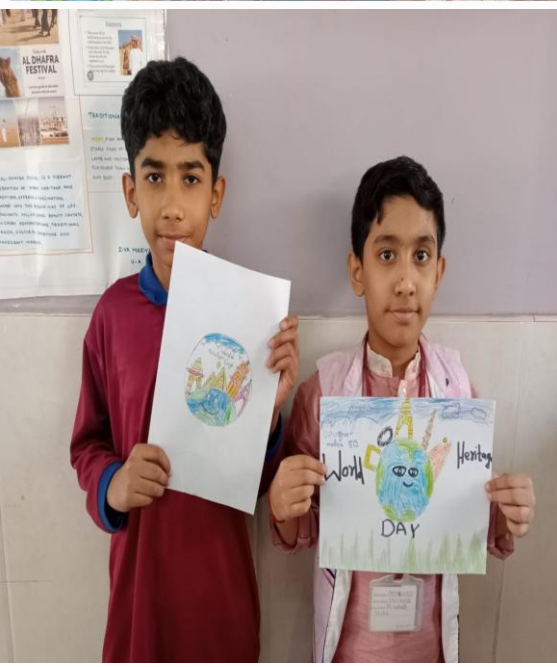
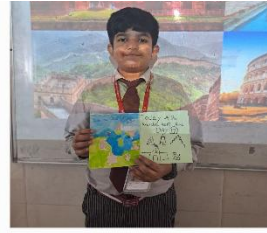
World Heritage Day, which is also known as the International Monuments and Sites Day, celebrates the work carried out by the ICOMOS – International Council on Monuments and Sites.








NUTRITION WEEK

Parental Engagement: School organized special meetings with parents to discuss the importance of providing nutritious meals at home and the role of the family in fostering healthy eating habits.

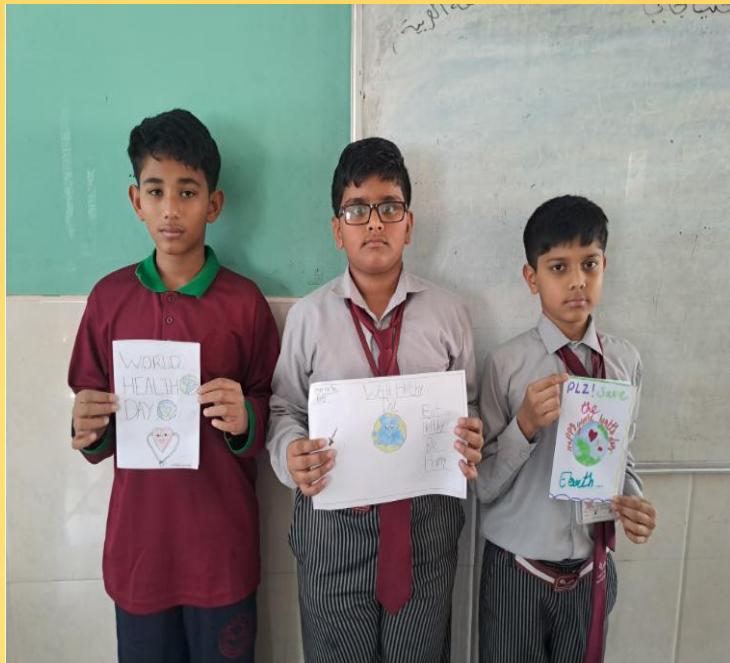
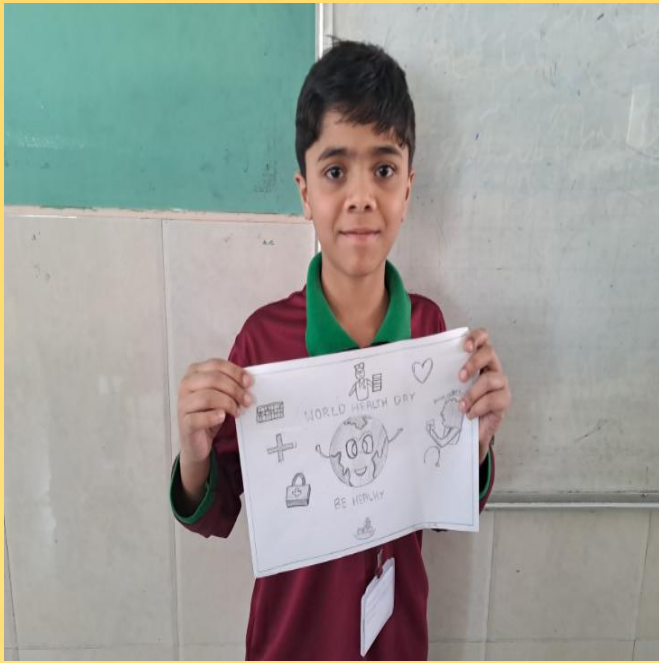

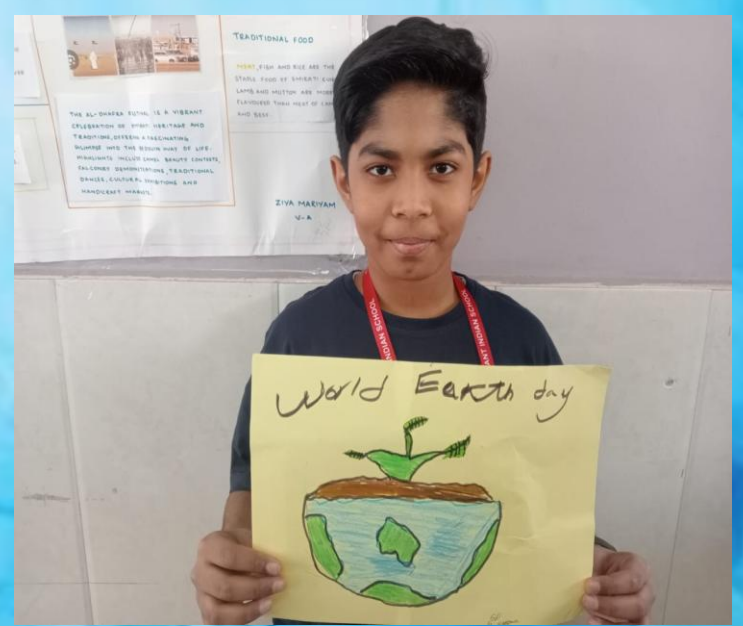
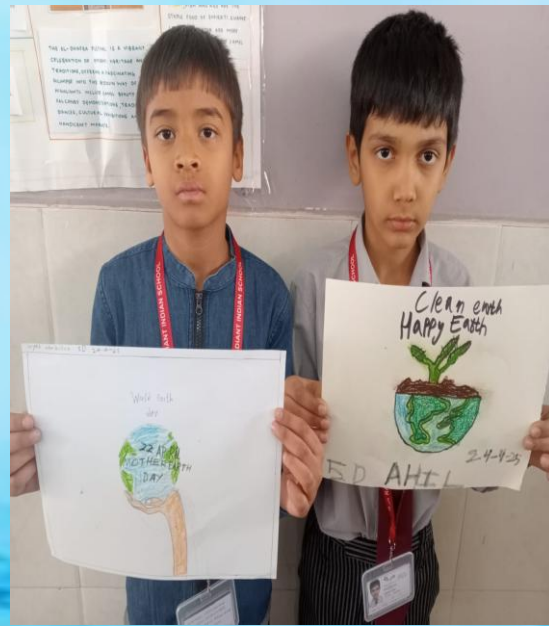




World Earth Day
