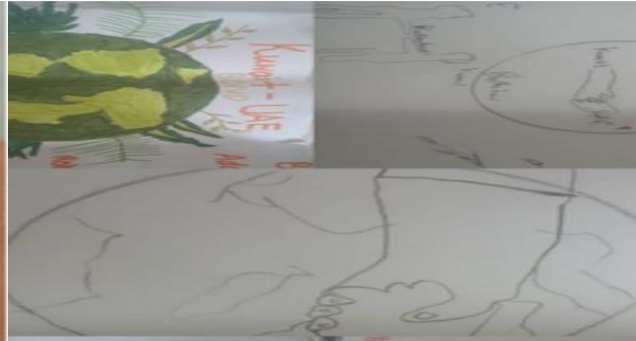
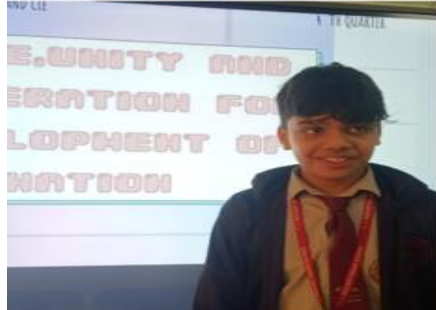
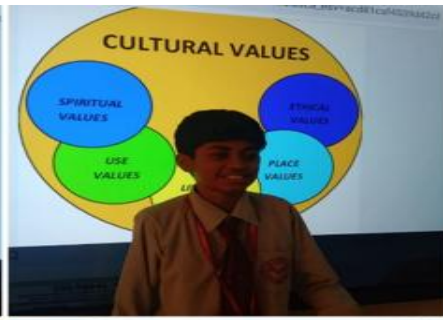
ACTIVITY ON UAE KUWAIT FRIENDSHIP DAY



Radiant School has conducted activities to understand the strong bond between the **UAE and Kuwait**.


Through **speech delivery and poster making**, students gained knowledge about the shared history, peace, cooperation, cultural respect, and mutual support between the two nations.
