The students were excited to explore a wide range of books from around the world, interact with authors, and participate in engaging educational workshops.






MATHEMATICS EXHIBITION

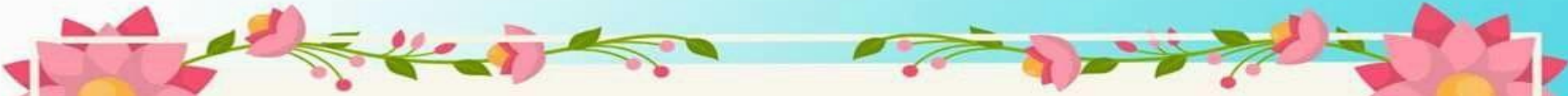
SCIENCE EXHIBITION

❖ Placard activity -Students prepared placards showcasing justice, liberty, equality, and fraternity.


❖ Preamble Reading Students present in morning assembly pledged preamble of Constitution of India

❖ Closing Ceremony -Vote of thanks and final message highlighting the importance of Constitution day



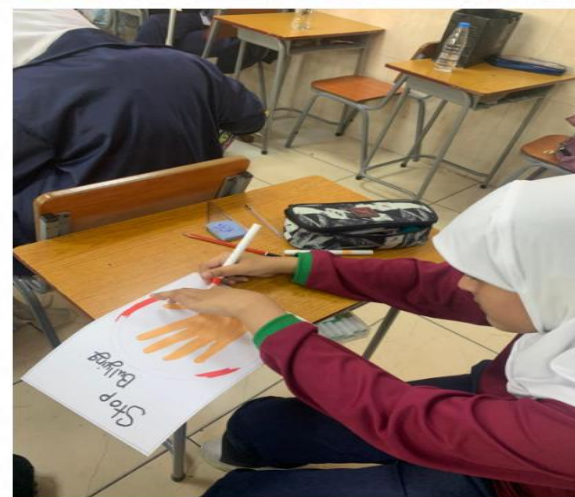
ANTI BULLYING AWARENESS PROGRAM

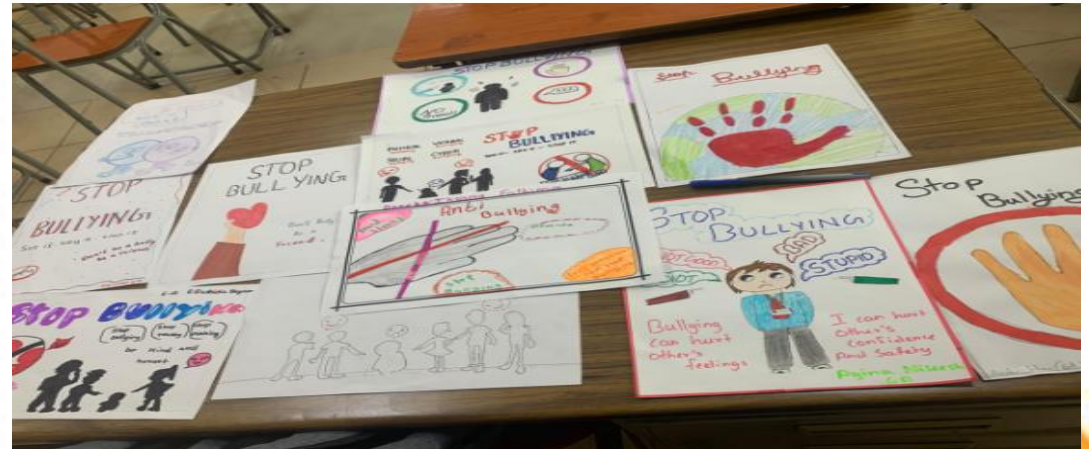
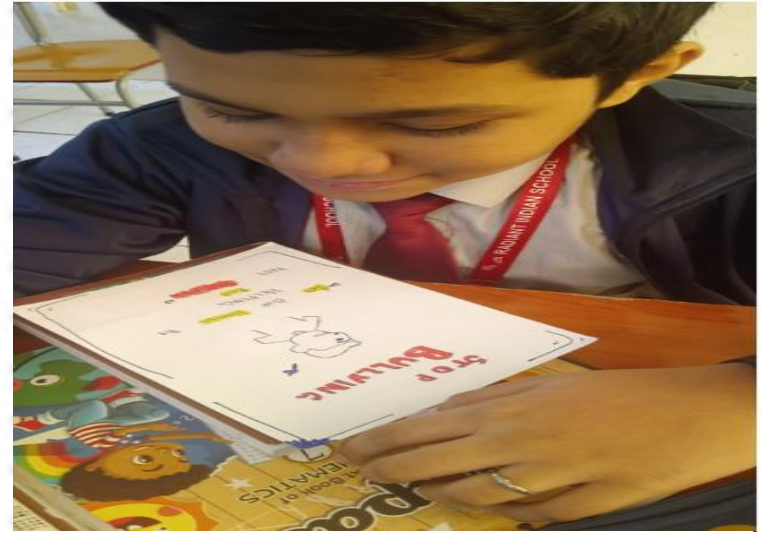

National Day 2025



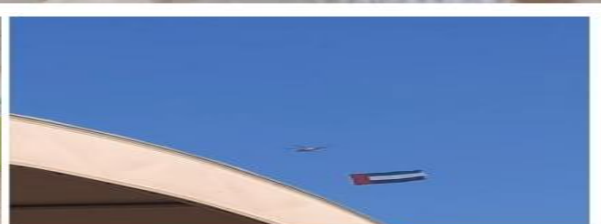
