During the assembly students conducted awareness speech on the importance of breast cancer awareness.


Teachers showed posters and videos to raise awareness about cancer, promote early detection, and support individuals and families affected by this devastating disease.


United Nations Day

OCTOBER 24TH

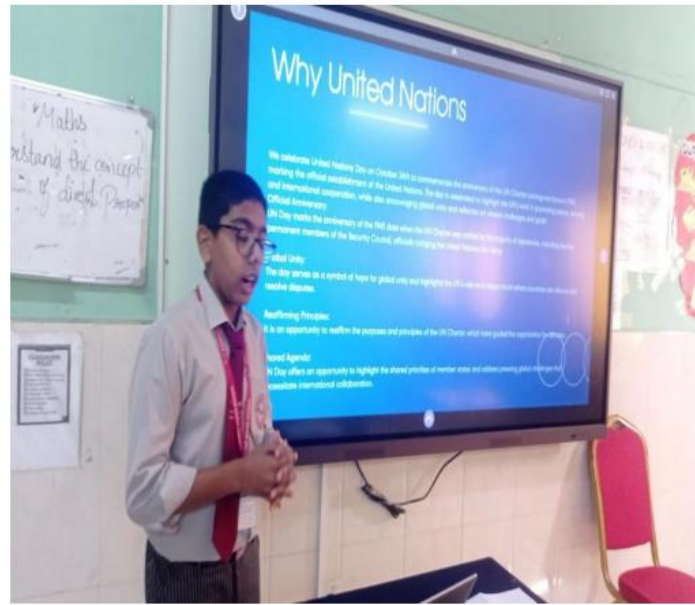


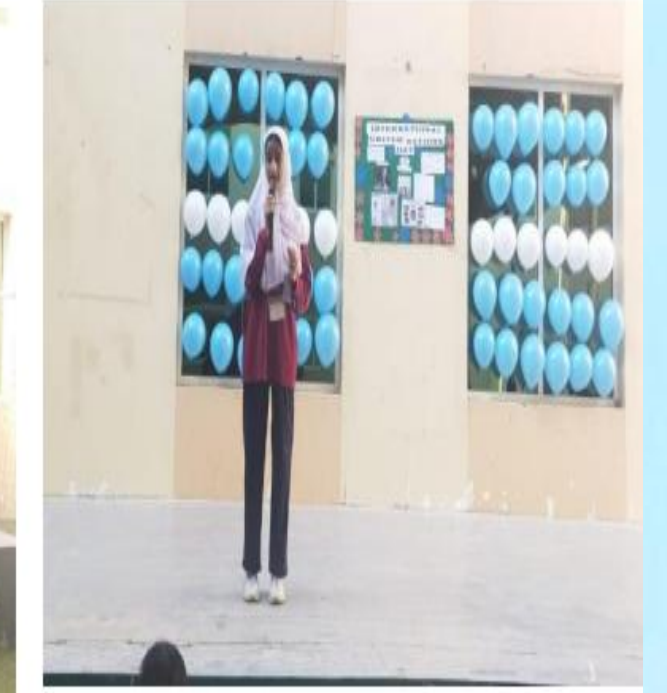
