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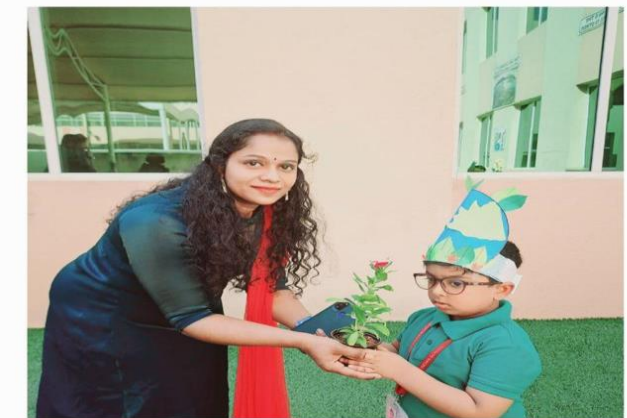


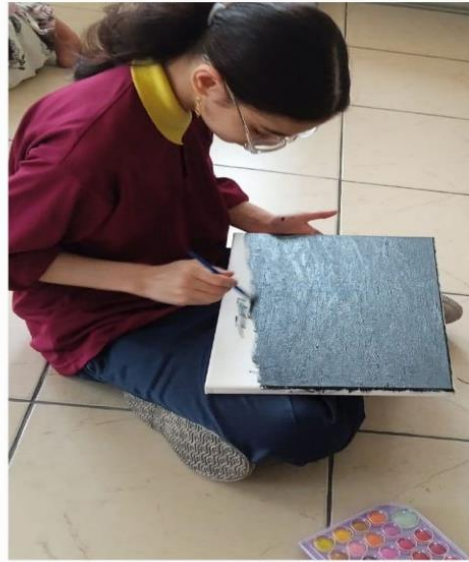

World day against child labour

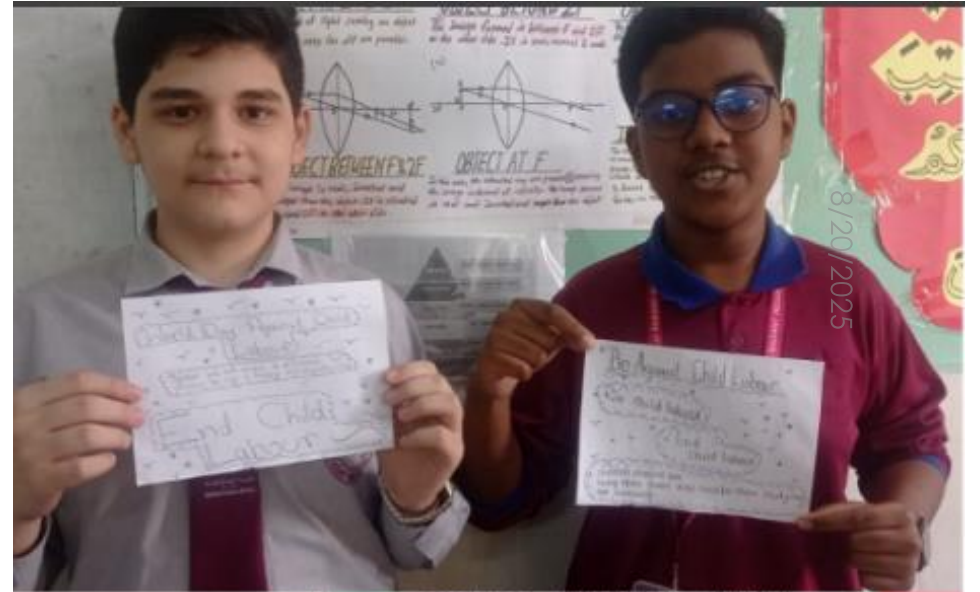
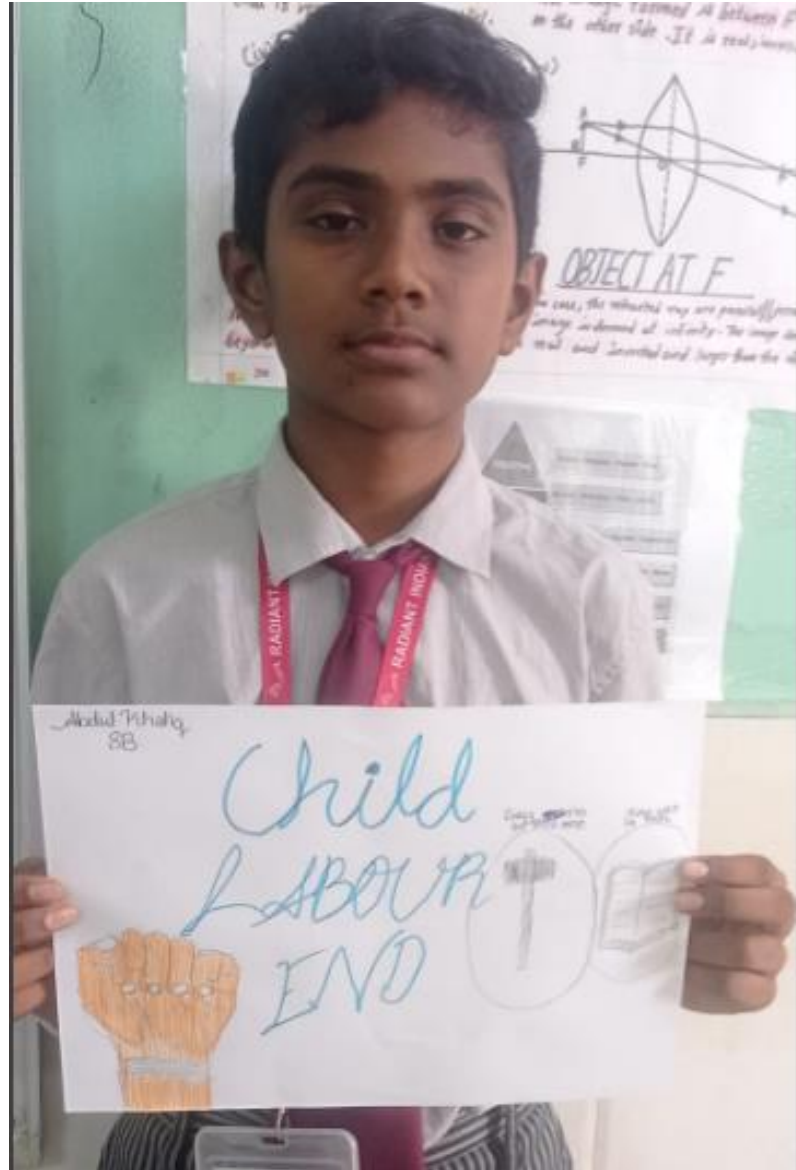

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Celebrating fatherhood

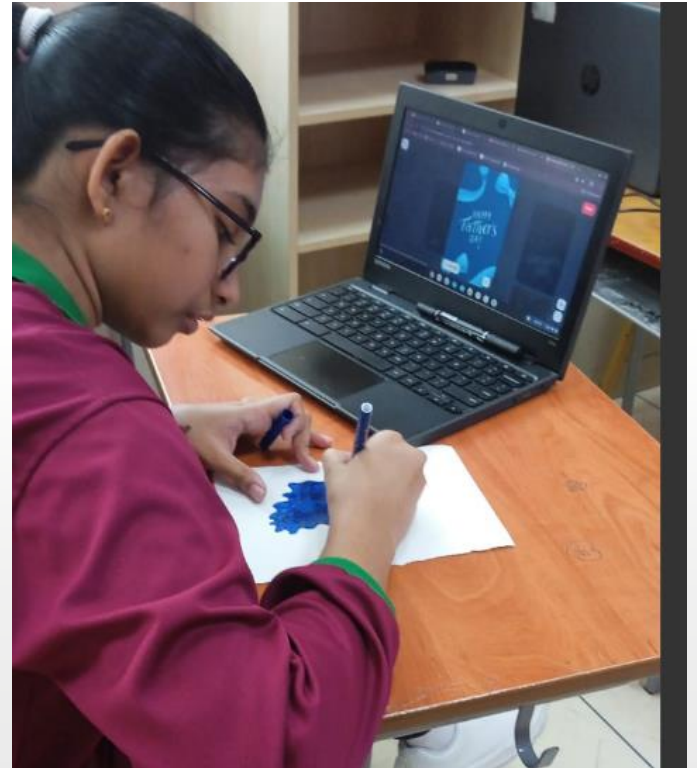

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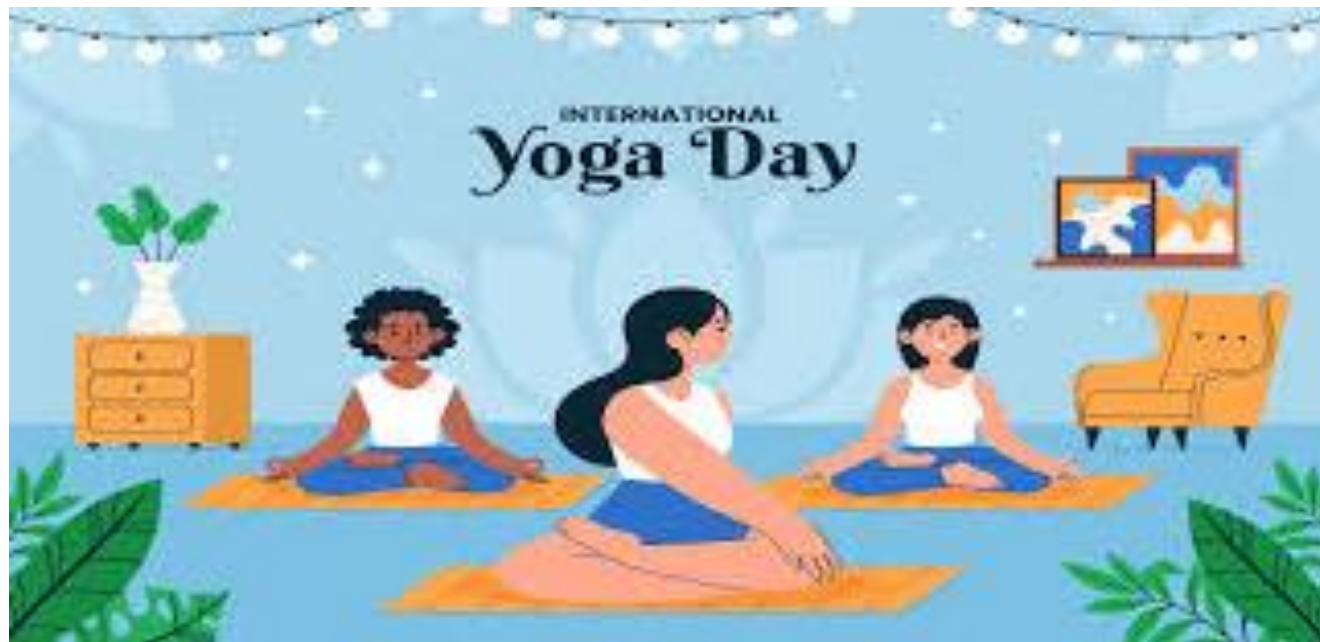




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"Yoga is not just a practice, it's a way of life that brings balance, strength, and peace — within and around us."
