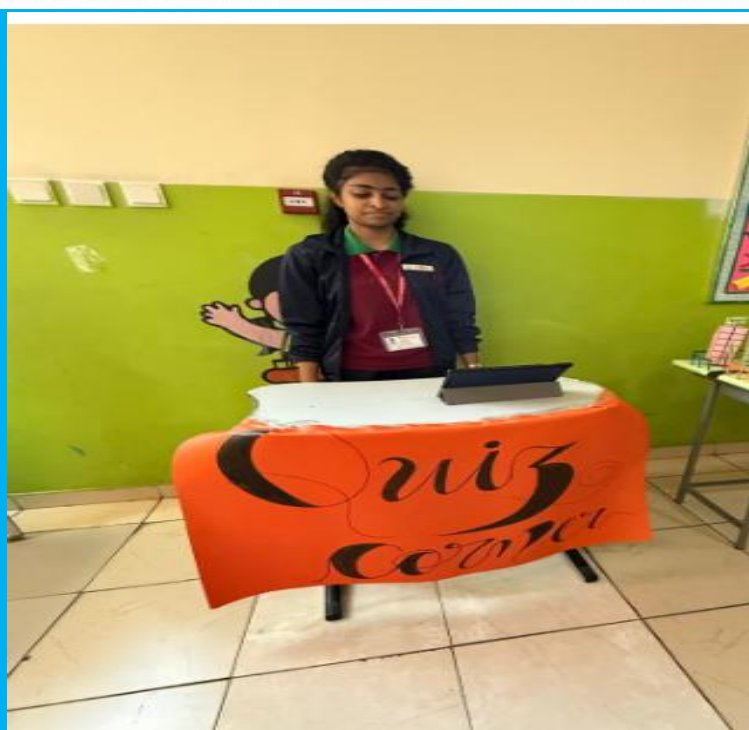


EXPLORICA

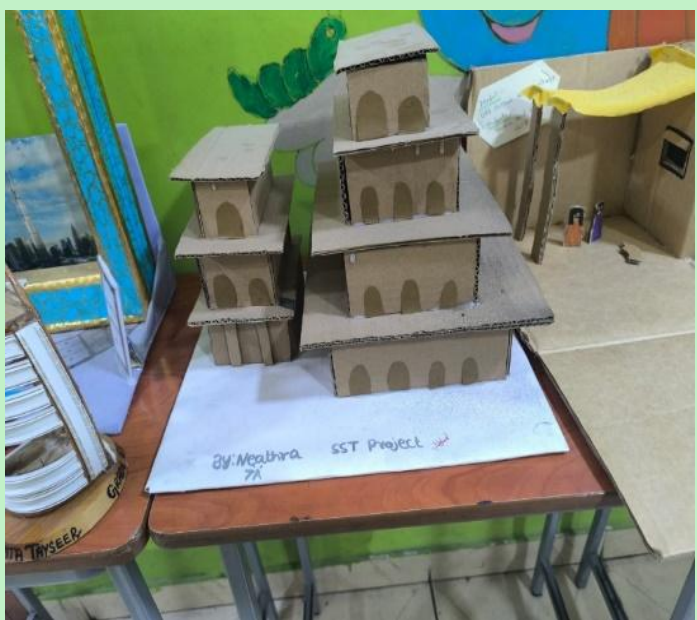
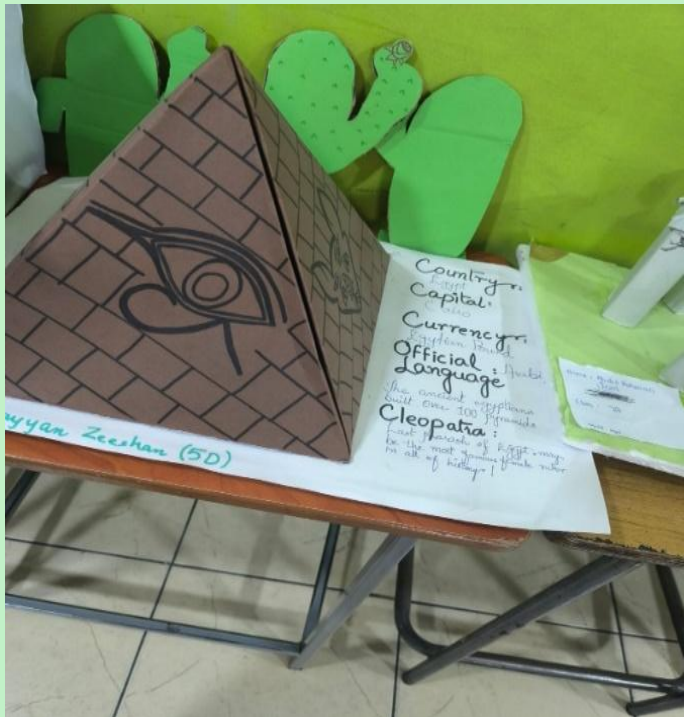
**SST EXHIBITION
