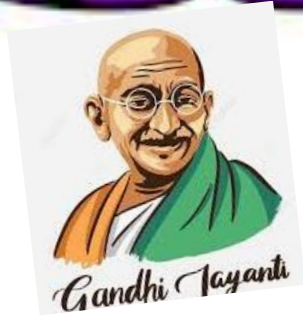
**OUR PRINCIPAL MESSAGE**

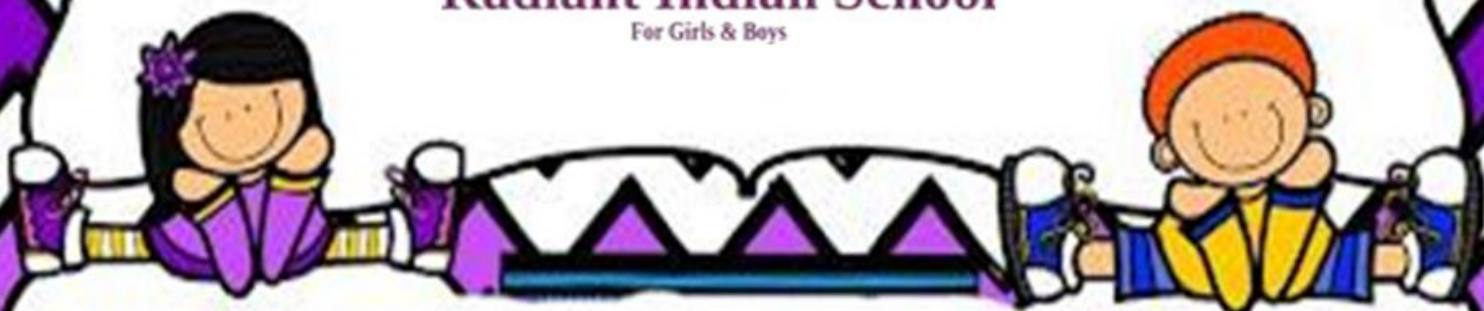
