SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

1. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to establish clear standards for the school uniform in order to promote discipline, equality, school identity, and a professional learning environment. Adherence to the uniform policy reflects the values of the school and supports a respectful academic atmosphere.

2. Scope

This policy applies to all students during school hours, while on school premises, and during any school-related activities, events, or official functions, unless otherwise authorized by the school administration.

3. General Requirements

All students must:

- Wear the complete and approved school uniform at all times.
- Ensure the uniform is clean, neat, and properly maintained.
- Wear the uniform in the correct manner without alteration.
- Maintain a tidy and respectful appearance while representing the school.

4. Standard School Uniform

Students are required to wear the following items as part of the official school uniform:

- School shirt with the school logo
- School trousers, skirt, or pinafore as specified by Radiant Indian school for Girls and Boys
- School jacket when required
- Black closed school shoes
- White school socks
- Physical Education (PE) uniform on designated sports days and assembly days

5. Hair and Head Covering Guidelines

Students must maintain neat and appropriate hairstyles consistent with school standards.

- Long hair must be neatly tied back during school hours.
- Students with long hair must use a plain white hair band or hair tie when securing their hair.
- Students who wear a head covering must wear a plain white scarf as part of the school uniform.
- Hairstyles that are extreme, distracting, or dyed in unnatural colors are not permitted.

6. Undergarments and Stockings (Girls)

To maintain modesty and uniform standards:

- Girls are required to wear **proper undergarments beneath the school uniform.**
- When wearing skirts or pinafores, girls must wear **plain white stockings (tights).**
- **White socks must be worn separately with school shoes,** even when stockings are worn where required.
- Stockings must be **plain, clean, and not visible outside the uniform.**

7. Jewelry and Accessories

To maintain safety and uniformity:

- Jewelry not permitted by the school.
- Large or decorative accessories are not permitted.
- Makeup, nail polish, and excessive accessories are not allowed.

8. Footwear

Students must wear plain black, closed school shoes.

Sports(white) shoes are permitted only during Physical Education classes or approved sports activities.

9. Non-Compliance

Failure to comply with the school uniform policy may result in:

- Verbal warning
- Notification to parents or guardians
- Requirement to correct the uniform immediately
- Disciplinary action in accordance with school regulations

Repeated violations will be treated as non-compliance with school conduct expectations.

10. Special Considerations

Any exemption due to medical, religious, or exceptional circumstances must be approved by the school administration with appropriate documentation.

11. Policy Review

The school reserves the right to review and update the uniform policy when necessary to ensure that it continues to support school values and standards.
